What do I do?

```
import os
import warnings
from django.core.exceptions import ImproperlyConfigured

def get_env_variable(var_name):
    """ Get the environment variable or return exception """
    try:
        return os.environ[var_name]
    except KeyError:
        error_msg = "Set the %s env variable" % var_name
        if DEBUG:
            warnings.warn(error_msg)
        else:
            raise ImproperlyConfigured(error_msg)
```

```
SECRET_KEY = get_env_variable("SECRET_KEY")
```

How do I get a new key?

```
$ python manage.py shell
```

```
>>> from django.utils.crypto import get_random_string
```

```
>>> get_random_string(length=50)
```
